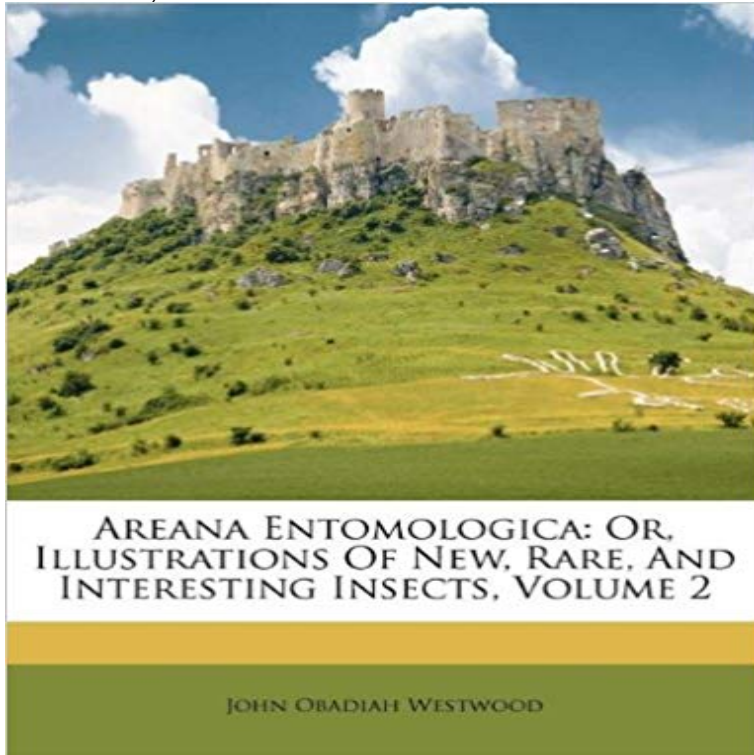


# Areana Entomologica: Or, Illustrations Of New, Rare, And Interesting Insects, Volume 2
