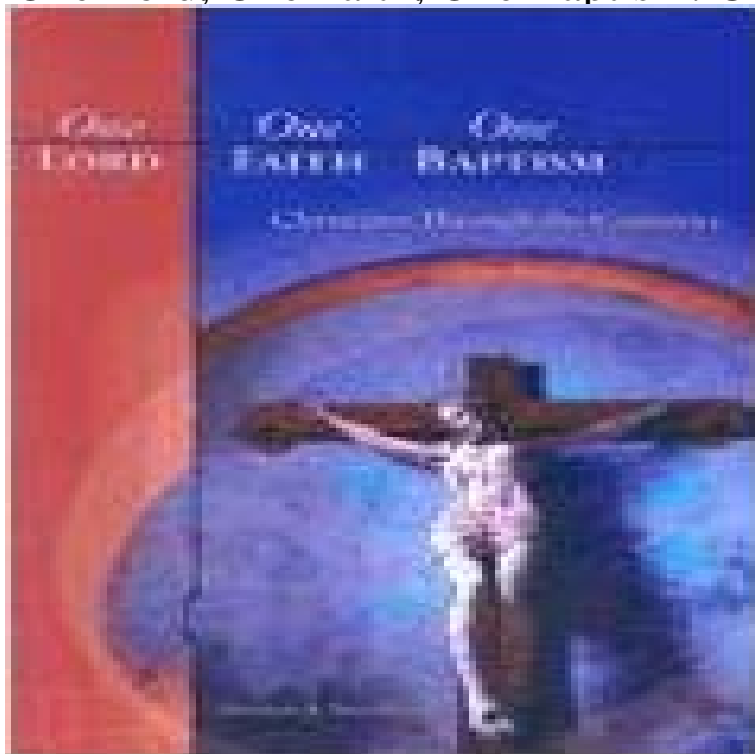


# One Lord, One Faith, One Baptism: Christians Through the Centuries
