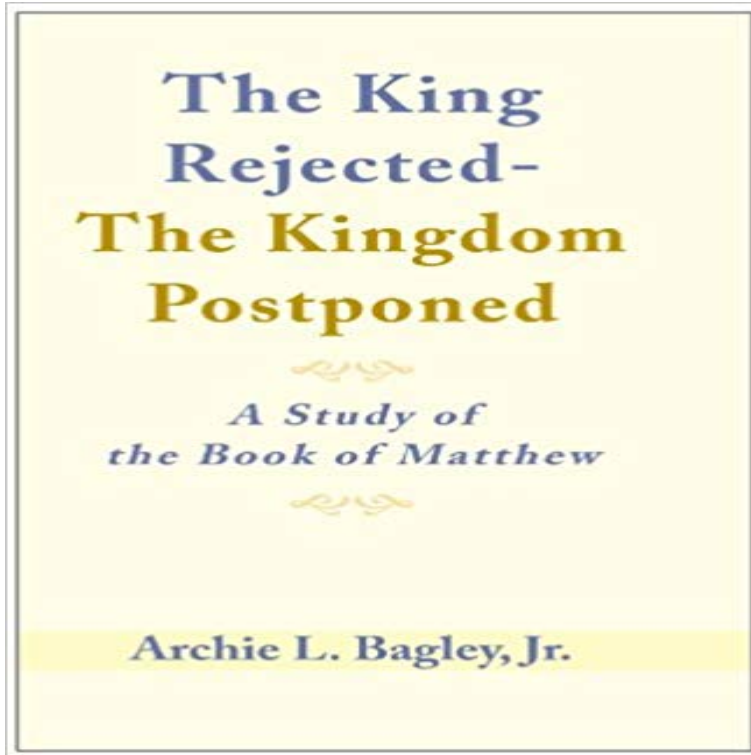


The King Rejected - The Kingdom Postponed : A Study of the Book of Matthew
