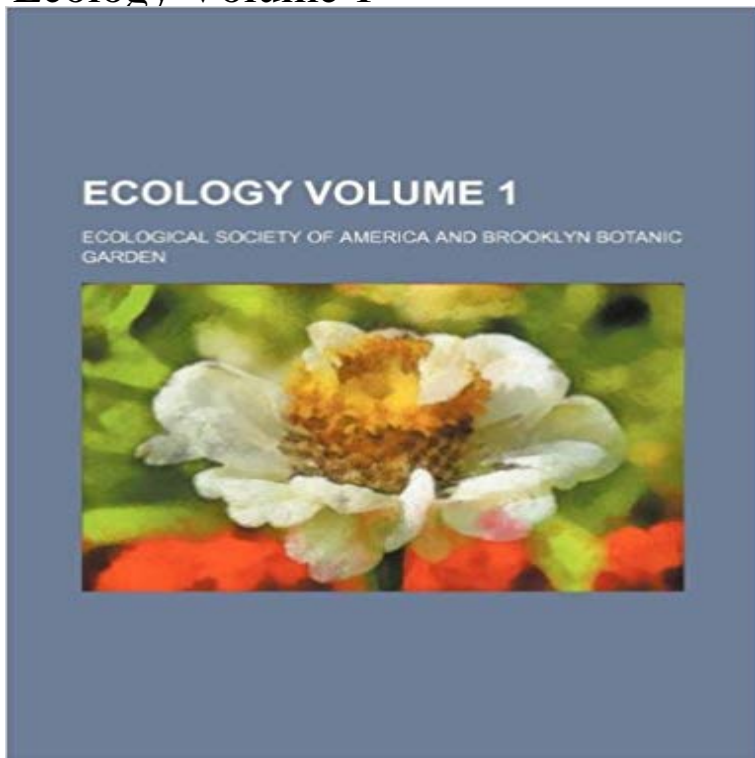

Directly (when treated with water alone) A. Inorganic. a. Strong, highly ionized acids, like hydrochloric, sulfuric, etc. b. Weak, slightly ionized acids, especially carbonic. c. Acid salts, like potassium acid sulfate, which may be moderately or slightly ionized (as acids). d. Salts of weak bases with strong acids, like aluminium chloride, ammonium sulfate, etc., which are slightly hydrolyzed and therefore yield a small amount of hydrogen-ion. B. Organic. a.
