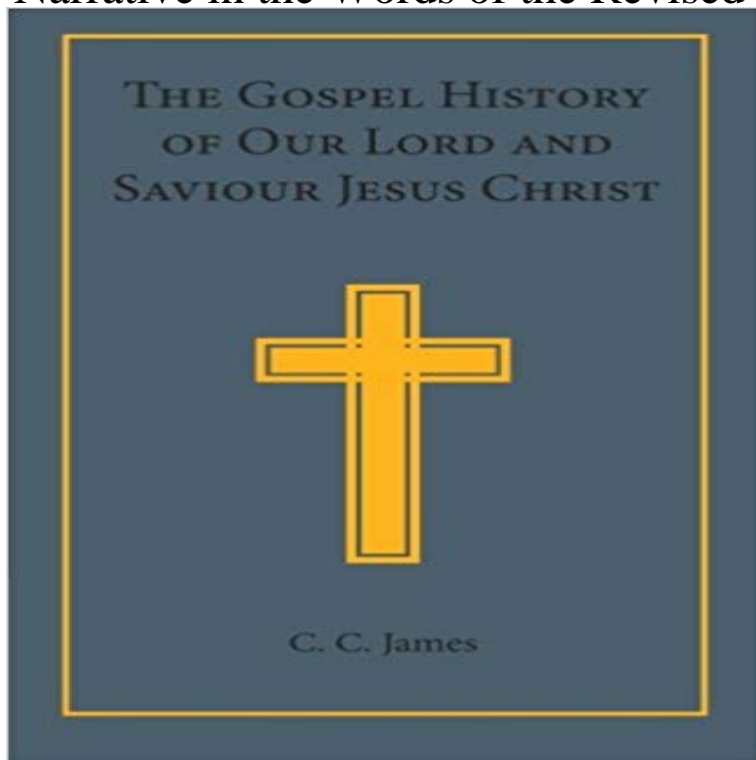


The Gospel History of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ: In a Connected Narrative in the Words of the Revised Version
